“What to Bring “Check-Off List

Everything that your son/daughter needs to bring to camp is noted on this list. We recommend including a copy of this list in their suitcase, so that when your child is packing to go home, he/she can check off each item. **Please do not bring a trunk. We recommend a medium sized suitcase and/or duffel bag. **REMINDER** Label all possessions!**

Please make sure your child brings enough clothes for their entire stay. On-Campus laundry facilities are not available. **The following recommendation is for a five-day stay:**

CLOTHING FOR DIVINE LITURGY WITH BISHOP WILLIAM:

- ❖ PROPER CHURCH ATTIRE
- ❖ NO SHORTS or T-Shirts with logos.
- ❖ Altar Servers may bring a cassock and/or dalmatic.

ENOUGH CLOTHING FOR A FIVE- DAY STAY & OTHER IMPORTANT ITEMS:

- ❖ Jeans, Capris, non-revealing shorts
- ❖ Shirts, T-Shirts – nothing revealing
- ❖ Sweater, Sweatshirt or light Jacket
- ❖ Sneakers or Sturdy Shoes – and plenty of socks (Sandals are permitted, however, they are not to be worn when playing sports or other physical activities)
- ❖ Rain jacket, baseball cap/hat
- ❖ Modest Bathing Suit
 - Girls: One Piece
 - Boys: Trunks
- ❖ Beach Towel
- ❖ Toothbrush, Toothpaste
- ❖ Soap, Shampoo, Brush/Comb
- ❖ Shower Shoes
- ❖ Sunscreen, Bug Spray
- ❖ Laundry Bag
- ❖ Modest Pajamas/Bathrobe

MEDICATION: Must be marked with camper’s name; will be kept in a special cabinet and supervised by the camp nurse.

LINENS:

- ❖ Pillow and Single Size Bed Sheet
- ❖ Sleeping Bag or Blanket
- ❖ Towel(s) and Face Cloth

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- ❖ Still Photo/Digital Camera
- ❖ Hair-dryer

REMEMBER TO MARK ALL OF YOUR POSSESSIONS!

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:

- ❖ Food, Beverages, Candy and Gum
- ❖ Pets of any kind
- ❖ **Cell Phones**, Pagers, Electronic Recording Devices (Camcorders), Lap Tops.
- ❖ *Gameboys* and other electronic games
- ❖ Electric Fans
- ❖ Fishing Poles
- ❖ Rollerblades, Heelies, Skateboards
- ❖ Cigarettes and other illegal substances
- ❖ Radios/CD Players/**iPods**
- ❖ Firearms, weapons and fireworks

FINAL WORD: Any camper caught stealing, tampering with equipment or property, building fires or using matches, leaving the grounds without permission, or engaging in inappropriate behavior, as determined by camp staff, will be sent home upon notification of parent or guardian.
